**October 6, 2014 Geneva, IL - John A. Cunningham**, Kane County Clerk, reminds Kane County residents that the **last day** to register to vote for the **November 4, 2014 General Election** is **October 7, 2014**. Most libraries, municipal, and township offices in Kane County do accept registrations until October 7, 2014.

- Grace Period Registration is an extension of the period of time for a voter to register to vote or to update their registration information. Once registered, this voter will cast their ballot during grace period for the General Election. Beginning Wednesday, **October 8<sup>th</sup>** through **October 17, 2014** Grace Period Registration and voting will be available in the Kane County Clerk's Office only.
- Five Permanent Early Voting Sites: Kane County Clerk's Office; Kane County Branch Court; Carpentersville Fire Station #3; Gail Borden Library; Elgin Township Office will offer **extended** grace period registration and voting beginning Monday, **October 20, 2014** until **7:00 pm on Tuesday, November 4, 2014**. Two forms of current identification are required to register to vote.
- Early Voting for the General Election will begin Monday, October 20, 2014 through Sunday, November 2, 2014. See the Kane County Clerk's website for details.

Registration will resume on **Thursday, November 6, 2014**.

The Kane County Clerk's Voter Registration office is located in Building B at the Kane County Government Center, 719 S. Batavia Avenue (Route 31), Geneva.

To register, a person must be a United States citizen, 18 years old on or before November 4, 2014, be a resident of the precinct for 30 days prior to the election, and provide two forms of identification, one of which shows their current name and address.
