September 15, 2014, Geneva, IL - John A. Cunningham, Kane County Clerk, would like to inform Kane County residents again about the change in the law for the Grace Period Voter Registration.

Public Act 98-691 "...**during the 2014 general election the (grace) period shall extend until the polls close on election day.** During this grace period, an unregistered qualified elector may register to vote.... **During the 2014 general election, an unregistered qualified elector may register to vote, and a registered voter may submit a change of address form, in person at any permanent polling place for early voting established under Section 19A-10 through election day.**"

To register and vote, a person must be a United States citizen, 18 years old on or before the date of the General Election, a resident of the precinct for 30 days prior to the election, and provide two forms of identification, one of which shows their current name and current address. Grace Period Voters must vote after their voter registration is processed. The Kane County Clerk's Voter Registration Office is located in Building B at the Kane County Government Center, 719 South Batavia Avenue (Route 31) in Geneva.

The Kane County Clerk's office will begin offering Grace Period Voter Registration and voting on **Wednesday, October 8, 2014 through October 17, 2014 from 8:30 am – 4:30 pm.** In addition, the Clerk has approved the following five Permanent Polling Place locations and schedules to begin offering Grace Period Voter Registration and Voting on Monday, October 20, 2014 for ONLY this November General Election:
