**February 2, 2015 Geneva, IL – John A. Cunningham**, Kane County Clerk announces a **Consolidated Primary will be held on Tuesday, February 24, 2015**. This Consolidated Primary will only be held for the Village of Campton Hills; therefore, the dates for the February Primary only affect people residing in the Village of Campton Hills. Residents of Campton Hills Village who still need to register or change their voter registration may utilize Grace Period Registration for the **Consolidated Primary**.

- Grace Period Registration for the **Consolidated Primary** (Village of Campton Hills) will be available in the Kane County Clerk's Office Only from **Monday, February 2, 2015** until **Saturday, February 21, 2015**. Once registered, this voter will cast their ballot during grace period for the Consolidated Primary. Voter registration will continue for all other Kane County residents. Two forms of current identification are required. The County Clerk's Office is open **Monday through Friday, 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM for voter registration**.
- Early Voting for the Consolidated Primary will begin on Monday, February 9, 2015 through Saturday February 21, 2015. See the Kane County Clerk's website for details.

Registration will resume on Thursday, February 26, 2015 for the Village of Campton Hills residents.

The Kane County Clerk's Voter Registration Office is located in Building B at the Kane County Government Center, 719 South Batavia Avenue (Route 31), Geneva.

To register, a person must be a United States citizen, 18 years old on or before the date of the next election, a resident of the precinct for 30 days prior to the election, and provide two forms of identification, one of which shows their current name and address.
